Samuel Norich is the president of the Forward Association, the not-for-profit that publishes the Yiddish and English *Forward* and served as its chief executive from the end of 1997 until June, 2017. He served as executive director of the YIVO Institute for Jewish Research from 1980 to 1992 and as a vice president of the World Jewish Congress from 1975 to 1981. Norich is the author of “What Will Bind Us Now: A Report on the Institutional Ties between Israel and American Jewry” (1994.) He also serves as treasurer of the Atran Foundation and is on the boards of Ameinu and the Jewish Labor Committee. He was born in Germany in 1947, the son of Polish Jews; immigrated with his family to New York in 1957; and was educated in the public schools, Columbia University, the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He lives in Brooklyn with his wife, the artist Deborah Ugoretz.
